

Public Presentation **Downtown Parking and Circulation**

The City of Cannon Beach will hold an open house on Wednesday, March 15, 2006, at 7:00 p.m. in the **Surfsand Ballroom, 148 W. Gower Street**, Cannon Beach (one block west of Hemlock Street on the north side of Gower Street, upper level of the Surfsand Resort lobby).

The City has initiated a design study to determine whether to convert a portion of the existing wastewater treatment lagoons into additional public parking to serve the downtown area. The design study will also examine potential improvements and modifications to pedestrian circulation in the downtown area.

The purpose of the open house is to present revised conceptual design alternatives with regard to the redevelopment of the wastewater lagoons and enhanced pedestrian circulation in the downtown area based on feedback received on the alternatives presented at the January 17 open house. The meeting is an opportunity for the public to provide comment on the revised design alternatives.
