

City of Cannon Beach **Invitation to Bid**

Sealed bids for the **Ecola Creek Bridge Seismic Improvements** will be received by Dan Grassick, Public Works Director, for the Owner, City of Cannon Beach, at 163 E Gower, Cannon Beach, Oregon 97110 at 2:00 p.m., Pacific Daylight Time, on Thursday, September 8, 2016 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud. No bids will be accepted after this time. All bidders shall submit, in a separate, sealed envelope, within two working hours of the bid opening time, on the bid date, a completed First-Tier Subcontractor Disclosure Form in compliance with ORS 279C.370.

The work for this project consists of removal of existing empty conduits on the upstream side of the bridge, installation of structural steel angles to expand the bearing width of each bridge support bent, and installation of pile clamps to secure the pilings to the timber bents above.

In general the elements of work include but are not limited to:

1. Removal of the existing empty conduits on the upstream side of the bridge located below the existing sidewalk above.
2. Installation of continuous structural steel angle through bolted to the existing wood support bents and to the concrete bridge deck above to provide expanded bearing surface for each bent.
3. Installation of piling brackets at the top of each timber piling to provide mechanical connection between the pilings and the timber bent above.
4. Installation of span ties along the upstream and downstream edges of the bridge below the sidewalk deck to provide a restraint connection between each set of bridge deck slabs.

All bidders shall comply with the provisions of ORS 279C.800-870 [workers on public works to be paid not less than prevailing rate of wage for projects over \$50,000.00]. Contractors submitting bids are required to be registered with the Construction Contractor's Board.

A pre-bid conference will not be held.

Bid security in the amount of not less than 10% of the bid must accompany each bid in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, and may reject, for good cause, any or all bids upon a finding of the Owner that it is in the public interest to do so in accordance with ORS 279C.395. The Owner reserves the right to waive any bid irregularities or informalities.

No bidder may withdraw or modify the bidder's bid after the hour set for the opening thereof, until after the lapse of 30 days from the bid opening.

The selected contractor is required to obtain a City business license prior to start of work.
