MATERIAL: Yard Debris Paper & Household Debris Wood and/or scrap lumber

- Permits are required for all burning.
- Burn Barrels must have a ¼" screen and be at least 10' from combustibles.
- The Permit Holder must provide a charged water hose.
- Fire may not be more than 4 feet in height and diameter.
- **Plastic, rubber, treated wood, synthetics, food waste, paint, hazardous materials and petroleum products are not allowed to be burned.**
- Burn piles or burn barrels must be attended continuously while burning is in progress.
- Burning will be during daylight hours only.
- Burning permits will not be issued during times of extreme dryness or during periods of high winds.
- Non-property owners are required to submit written permission from the owner of the property before a permit will be issued. This includes but is not limited to builders, landscapers, and/ or renters.
- Any complaint of a smoke problem may result in the Fire Chief or his designee ordering extinguishment of the fire.
