

NOTICE UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

Auxiliary Aids and Services

In accordance with the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, plus amendments of 2008, the City of Cannon Beach does not discriminate against qualified individuals with disabilities on the basis of disability in the City's services, programs or activities.

The City of Cannon Beach will provide appropriate auxiliary aids and services, including qualified sign language interpreters and assistive listening devices, whenever necessary to insure effective communication with members of the public who have hearing, sight or speech impediments, unless to do so would result in a fundamental alteration of its programs. If you desire the use of an auxiliary aid or service to participate in a City of Cannon Beach program, service or activity, please contact the office of the City of Cannon Beach ADA Coordinator, Rich Mays at 503-436-8050 (voice) or 503-436-8097 (TTY) as far in advance as possible but no later than 48 hours before the scheduled event.

The City of Cannon Beach will not place a surcharge on a particular individual with a disability, or any group of individuals with disabilities, to cover the cost of providing auxiliary aids and services, or reasonable modifications of policy.
