The Cannon Beach Disaster Animal Response Team (CBDART) is a volunteer organization committed to assisting community and pet owners alike with emergency preparedness and caching of supplies for domestic animals. Our organization coordinates and collaborates on training necessary to ensure effective emergency response, veterinary first aid and companion-to-family reunification. Our members mobilize to bring structure, skill, comfort and compassion to both prevent and mitigate the consequences of disaster.

Volunteer Credentialing Requirements

Volunteers must complete and have on record the following to be a fully credentialed CBDART member:

- Volunteer Registration Form*
- New Member Orientation Session
- Successful Criminal Records Check
- Signed Code of Conduct
- Photo ID Badge
- Mandatory training, which ranges to include:
 - Incident Command Series (100, 200, 700)
 - Standard CPR/First Aid and Animal First Aid Courses
 - Introduction to Animal Emergency Management Issues (e.g. animal handling)
- Maintain personal disaster plans

*The CBDART Coordinator will call individuals after submission of their Volunteer Registration Form to schedule an appointment for a new member orientation session and provide additional direction about next steps (e.g. criminal records check, Photo ID). There is no charge to CBDART members for credentialing requirements.
