

BEFORE THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANNON BEACH

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING ORDINANCE 98-15 AND) ORDINANCE 18-07
GRANTING RECOLOGY, AN OREGON CORPORATION,)
A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO COLLECT AND)
DISPOSE OF SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLABLE)
MATERIALS FOR UP TO TWO MONTHS)

WHEREAS, Recology and the City have been discussing a new franchise relationship since September 2018; and

WHEREAS, the parties need more time to reach a new 20-year agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to extend the terms of the expiring franchise for a maximum of two additional months in order to provide more time; and


WHEREAS, because the current franchise expires on January 1, 2019, the City must pass an emergency ordinance to ensure no gap in coverage in January 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF CANNON BEACH COUNCIL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City grants a limited Franchise to Recology under the terms of Ordinance 98-15, except as noted herein.
2. The parties agree that the annual cost of living rate adjustment for 2018 under Section 13.12.330(G) of the Cannon Beach Municipal Code is three and one-half percent (3.5%). The effective date of such adjustment is hereby deferred from July 1, 2018 to January 1, 2019. Such deferral shall not affect the timing of subsequent rate adjustments.
3. The recycling fee provided for in Section 13.12.300(B) of the Cannon Beach Municipal Code and Section 4.3 of Ordinance 98-15 is hereby increased from fifteen percent (15%) to sixteen percent (16%) of the franchisee's gross revenues, effective January 1, 2019.
4. Section 3 of Ordinance 98-15 is repealed.
5. This ordinance is an emergency and shall become effective on January 1, 2019. Without such an ordinance, the City would not have a solid waste franchise in place.
6. This ordinance shall expire on March 1, 2019 unless repealed at an earlier date.


