WHEREAS, the city budgeted for improvements to replace water line along E. Harrison in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 budget in the amount of \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, the bids received were greater than what was anticipated in the 2023-2024 budget; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bid came in at \$153,871; and

WHEREAS, to fund the project cost of \$169,258 which includes an additional 10% for project costs, the use of budgeted contingency from the Water Reserve fund will be required; and

WHEREAS, contingency of \$19,258 from the Water Reserve Fund will be used to add to the existing budgeted project cost of \$150,000. This will increase expenditures in the Water Reserve fund in the amount of \$19,258; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Cannon Beach hereby adopts the following FY 2023-2024 budget changes to the following fund.
