WHEREAS, The City of Cannon Beach is the process of restoring and re-envisioning the former elementary school into a tourism-related facility; and

WHEREAS, the Cannon Beach City Council desires to involve the citizens in the process; and

WHEREAS, the Cannon Beach City Council desires to have an independent citizen group research how other entities operate and maintain similarly sized facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, through Resolution 23-09, formed the Cannon Beach Elementary School Rejuvenation Research Advisory Committee ("Committee"), a 7-member advisory committee tasked with researching the use, operational budget and management of similar facilities at other entities. This advisory committee will report its findings and suggestions to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Committee has been meeting for the past four months and Dick Basch from the Clatsop Nehalem Tribe has been an integral part of the process; and

WHEREAS, the Committee would like to include a member of the Clatsop Nehalem Tribe as a member of the Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Cannon Beach hereby:

Section 1: Expands the Cannon Beach Elementary School Rejuvenation Research Advisory Committee to include one member of the Clatsop Nehalem Tribe.

Section 2: Appoints Dick Basch as the current representative of the Clatsop Nehalem Tribe on the Cannon Beach Elementary School Rejuvenation Research Advisory Committee.
